P R O C L A M A T I O N

- WHEREAS, December 7, 1968 marks the 27th anniversary of Pearl Harbor; and
- WHEREAS, December 7, recalls a day that Americans will never forget and whose significance must be taught to our youth; and
- WHEREAS, the Pearl Harbor survivors stand as a living testimony of the savage and unprovoked attack upon our Nation at Pearl Harbor, and of our continuing obligation to be prepared to defend ourselves.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim December 7, 1968 as

"PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY"

in Minnesota and urge attention to the proper commemoration of this event in American history, and due honor to the defenders of Pearl Harbor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
