EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 1968.


You are therefore by these presents, appointed and commissioned JUDGE OF THE HENNEPIN  
COUNTY MUNICIPAL COURT as aforesaid,


TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said office of JUDGE OF THE HENNEPIN COUNTY
