ORDINANCE NO. 382

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE COMPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCERDING TWO HUNDRED (200) ACRES.

- A MINNEY COMMON COMMO

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minneseta, by all the owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

The West One-half of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (W2SW2SW2) of Section Three (3), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) Morth, Range Fortyone (41), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian.

Section 2. The description of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded and described is 20 acres more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the ammeration will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, hereby ordsins and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been appart thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Mamicipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
