ANNEXATION ORDINANCE**

All ordinance annexing certain unplatted lands under 200 acres of area to the Village of Grand Rapids and extending the boundaries of said village to include lands described herein and declaring such lands annexed to the village.

Whereas, a certain petition dated June 29, 1968, requesting annexation of territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 10th day of July, 1968, and

Whereas, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately five (5) acres of unplatted land no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough, and

Whereas, the petition was signed by the two (2) owners of said property, and

Whereas, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

Whereas, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the west boundary thereof,

The council of the Village of Grand Rapids, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines: (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the village and of the property affected; (2) that the territory described therein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof: (a) East 700 Feet of the North 300 Feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Fifty-five (55) North, Range Twenty-five (25) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Council is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
