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AN ORDINANCE DIVIDING CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE  
VILLAGE OF BETHEL.

The Village Council of the Village of Bethel do  
ordain as follows:-

Section 1.

That the following described lands are hereby set off  
from the Village of Bethel, to become a part of the Townships  
in which they are located, as voted upon at a Special Election  
held in said Village, according to law.

The North half of the Northeast quarter of Section 35,  
the Southeast quarter and South half of Northeast quarter of  
Section 26, the South half and the Southhalf of the North half  
of Section 36, also the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter  
of said Section 36, and the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter  
and the West half of Southwest quarter of Section 25, all in  
Township 34, Range 24, and the East half, also East half of West  
half and Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section 30, all  
in Township 34, Range 23, Anoka County, State of Minnesota.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its  
passage.


