
Dear Sir:

ORDINANCE NO. 129

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR HOLDING OF VILLAGE ELECTION ON THE
FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER OF EACH YEAR

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PRESTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Village Election to be Held on First Tuesday after the First Monday in November. The regular Village election shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of every year. This ordinance is made and passed pursuant to authority granted to the Village Council of the Village of Preston in Minnesota Statutes, Sec. 205.07.

Section 2. Certification by Village Clerk of the Change in Time of Village Election. The Village Clerk shall immediately certify a notice in writing to the Fillmore County Auditor and to the Secretary of State, State of Minnesota, of the change of date of the Village election as provided herein, and shall forthwith send a certified copy of this ordinance to said County Auditor and Secretary of State.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
