

PROCLAMATION


WHEREAS, the United States of America, pursuant to federal law and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, will be able to make available to the State of Minnesota funds for a feasibility study for a custom natural iron ore palletizing facility which would serve the Upper Great Lakes Region, and


WHEREAS, no state agency has been otherwise designated by law to apply for, receive and accept such federal funds, and

WHEREAS, the United States of America has indicated willingness to contract with the State of Minnesota through the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation,


