WHEREAS, a viable vocational-technical education system is essential for the future development of our human and economic resources, and


WHEREAS, vocational-technical education is entering its fifty-first year of service to Minnesota citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 25 - March 2, 1968, as


"VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION WEEK"
