WHEREAS, the League of United Latin American Citizens, better known as LULAC, in this year 1968 A. D. is observing its Thirty-ninth Anniversary, and

WHEREAS, since its founding LULAC has placed particular emphasis on the development of character, training in citizenship and the promotion of the Ideals of our American Way of Life through education, and

WHEREAS, the Cardinal Principle of LULAC stresses the preservation of the Rights of all Americans, fostering the Ideals of Freedom, Peace, and Unity;
