WHEREAS, Industrial Arts is an integral part of the total program of education in the school systems of the State of Minnesota, and the other States in our Nation, and

WHEREAS, Industrial Arts is designed specifically to help prepare youth to meet the requirements of our industrial-technological society, and

WHEREAS, the American Industrial Arts Association and the State of Minnesota have invited educational leaders from all regions of the United States to convene in Minneapolis to further this program of education, and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Minnesota have been credited with an exceptionally fine educational program and many industrial-technological discoveries,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 30 - May 3, 1968, as

"INDUSTRIAL ARTS WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to lend their support to the Industrial Arts programs in the schools in their communities.
