## PROCLAMATION

WHICHEAS. the purpose of Brotherhood Week is to symbolise renewed dedication to the causes of freedom, equality, and national unity among all citizens and might well be lost if the evils of poverty, spathy, ignorance and bigotry were allowed to prevail, and

WHEREAS. the National Conference of Christians and Jews is diligently working to establish a social order in which the religious ideals of brotherhood and justice shall become the stendards of human relationships and in furtherance of these goals undersake to sponsor prothermood Week for the education of our citizens to their individuel responsibility in these efforts, and

WHEREAS, if unity is ever to be achieved, education for better human relations must continue not only during Brotherhood Week, but throughout the year in our schools and colleges, in our churches and synagogues, and

WIEREAS, the people of Minnesots, though drawn from many verted backgrounds of race, religious faith and national origin, are unified in their devotion to their country and to the American way of life founded upon basic rights guaranteed by the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lavander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 18 - 25, 1968, as

in Minnesote, and urge all of our people to observe this week so that it may be a period in which to reaffirm our determination that equality and individual liborties shall be preserved in a spirit of brotherhood and understanding.
