WHEREAS, more than 30,000 young volunteers -- the School Safety Patrol Officers -- have again, as they have for nearly fifty years, kept these children from being traffic fatalities, and

WHEREAS, this great service to the people of Minnesota is often performed with great discomfort and sacrifice by these dedicated young officers, and

WHEREAS, it is most fitting that a special time be set aside as a tribute to the boys and girls who serve so faithfully and that time be one when adults can extend these officers the special commendation they desire,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 17 - 24, 1968, as
