PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF HATFIELD

PIPESTONE COUNTY, MINNESOTA

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Pipestone, Minnesota.

We, the undersigned, being twenty-five or more legal voters actually residing upon the land within that certain district and territory hereinafter described, do hereby petition your honorable body to approve and grant this application, and we do hereby request that you appoint a time and place when and where the electors, actually residing within the district and territory hereinafter described, may vote for or against the incorporation, under the laws of the State of Minnesota, of a village to be named Hatfield.

Any your petitioners further allege:

That the tract of land, district and territory above referred to and to be included within said proposed village is described as follows:
