ORDINANCE NO. 131

An ordinance annexing certain territory therein described to the Village of New Richland, Minnesota.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHLAND, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: WHEREAS, the owners of the tract, parcel and piece of land abutting upon or contiguous to the corporate limits of the Village of New Richland, hereinafter described, have petitioned the Common Council of the Village of New Richland, Minnesota, to have the following described property situate in the County of Waseca and State of Minnesota, annexed to the Village of New Richland, to-wit:

Block Eight (8) in Zieger's Subdivision in the East One-half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Seventeen (17), Township One Hundred Five (105) North, Range Twenty-two (22) West, together with the North One-half of Pillsbury Street from the center of St. Thomas Street to the center of Wagner Street, and the alley within Block Eight (8), and the East One-half of St. Thomas Street from the South line of Langdon Street to the center of Pillsbury Street and the West One-half of Wagner Street from the South line of Langdon Street to the center of Pillsbury Street, all being in Zieger's Subdivision, New Richland Township, Waseca County, Minnesota.

WHEREAS, The Petitioners are all of the owners of said property and the owners adjacent to the streets therein named, and whereas the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of New Richland and the territory affected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHLAND, MINNESOTA, Pursuant to the authority and provisions of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, Section 414.03, Subd. 2;

Section 2. That the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to the Village of New Richland, Minnesota.

Section 3. IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED AND ORDERED, That a duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Waseca County, Minnesota.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication, and other filings required by the above cited statute.
