Now therefore,

The Village Council of the Village of Saint Michael Station do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the name of the Village of Saint Michael Station be and hereby is changed to Albertville as the corporate name of said Village.

Section 2. There being no newspaper published in said village, the Council hereby directed that this ordinance be published according to law in the Buffalo Journal, a legal weekly newspaper, published at the village of Buffalo, Minn., in the county of Wright and State of Minnesota.

Section 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance is hereby directed to be filed one each with the County Auditor of the said county of Wright, and with the Secretary of State of the said State of Minnesota.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its due publication according to law and the due filing of said copies hereof as hereinbefore provided.

Whereas the United States postal authorities have heretofore designated Albertville as the name of the United States post office in the Village of Saint Michaels Station and said village is generally known and called Albertville.

Now therefore

The Village Council of the Village of Saint Michaels Station do enact as follows:

Section 1. That the name of the said Village of Saint Michaels Station be and is hereby changed to "Albertville" as the proper name of said Village.

Section 2. That any and all papers published in said village in violation of the laws of the State of Minnesota be published according to law in the Buffalo Journal a legal weekly newspaper published in the village of Buffalo, in said County of Wright and State of Minnesota.

Section 3. That a true and correct copy of this ordinance be filed with the County Auditor of this County of Wright and with the Secretary of State of the said State of Minnesota.
