## ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BENSON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated September 25, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 5th day of October, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners of said land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the westerly boundary thereof;

The City of Benson does ordain:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the city and of the territory affected (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. <u>Territory Annexed</u>. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and

included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Beginning at the Northeast (NE) corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)-NE\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Section Seven (7), Township One Hundred Twenty-one (121), Range Thirty-nine (39), thence Westerly (Wly) along the North (N) line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{4}\)-NE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) a distance of One Hundred Thirty-seven feet (137'), thence Southerly (Sly) a distance of Two Hundred Twenty-three feet (223'), thence Easterly (Ely) a distance of One Hundred Thirty-seven feet (137') to the East (E) line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)-NE\(\frac{1}{2}\)), thence Northerly (Nly) along said East (E) line a distance of Two Hundred Twenty-three feet (223') to place of beginning, all being in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW\(\frac{1}{2}\)-NE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section Seven (7), Township One Hundred Twenty-one (121), Range Thirty-nine (39), and subject to existing highway and storm sewer easements.

Section 3. <u>Filing</u>. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and thirty days after publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
