ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WINTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED IN PART BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WINTON:

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory abuts upon the corporate limits of the Village of Winton at the northerly boundary thereof and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, this territory is in part owned in fee by the Village of Winton, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the owners and residents of the property proposed to be incorporated have petitioned the Village of Winton to be incorporated as a part of said Village, NOW THEREFORE,

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WINTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Territory Annexed The corporate limits of the Village of Winton are hereby extended to include the platted property, including Outlots, described as follows now in part owned by the Village of Winton;

Lots One (1), to Thirty Six (36) inclusive and Outlots A, B, C, D and E, St. Croix Plat, located in Gov't. Lot 1 and N. 15.2 Ac. of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 24, T 63 N-R 12 W. 4 P. M. according to plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds, in and for St. Louis County, Minnesota.

Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County of St. Louis in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective Date of Annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.

FRED C. LOUIS and it has its known office of issue in the CITY OF ELY in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by THE PUBLISHER or persons in HIS employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and AT WHICH SAID NEWSPAPER IS PRINTED. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1866, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by THE PUBLISHER OF SAID NEWSPAPER and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
