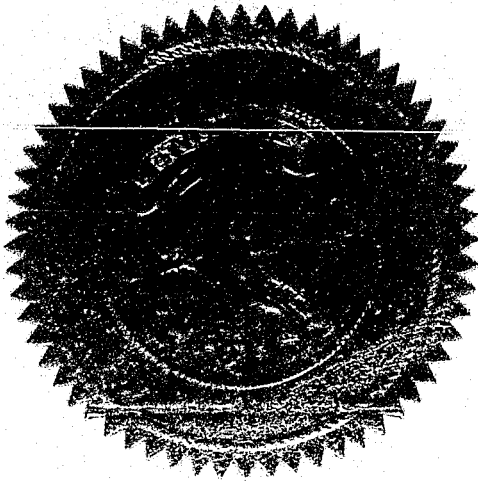
PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, Edward H. Foley, Deputy Sheriff of Sherburne County, was murdered on the evening of September twenty-seventh, 1919, at Elk River, while assisting in the attempt to capture three bandits in an automobile; and

WHEREAS, Public welfare requires the arrest and punishment of these bandits;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Governor of the State of Minnesota, will cause to be paid out of the Treasury of the State of Minnesota the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the arrest and conviction of each of said bandits.
