PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there are 1,900 public and private schools participating in the School Lunch Program in Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, there are 550,000 school children who enjoy 1/3 of their daily nutritional requirements derived from this program, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota schools purchased locally \$19.5 million of food products during the 1968 school year, and

WHEREAS, agriculture contributes a major part of the State's economy, and it is important that our schools endeavor at all times to serve Minnesota foods, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting we salute our Agricultural Industry and our School Lunch Program in Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of January 20-24, 1969 as

"ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS"

and urge all schools of this State to participate in serving a complete menu of foods produced and processed in Minnesota,

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
