PETITION.

To the County Board of
Kittson County, Minnesota.

Whereas, none of the territory hereinafter described is within the limits of an incorporated village or city and part of the same has been heretofore platted into lots and blocks as shown by the duly and legally certified plats of the townsite of Humbolt and the First Addition to Humbolt on file and of record in the office of the register of deeds of Kittson County, Minnesota, and

Whereas the undersigned desire to have the hereinafter described territory incorporated as a village to be named "Humbolt", and

Whereas the undersigned did on Aug. 23, 1919, cause to be taken, a census of the people residing upon said territory and did thereby determine that said territory contains 180 people actually residing thereon.

Therefore your petitioners, who are twenty-five or more of the voters residing upon said territory respectfully request your honorable board to call an election as required by law, to determine the question of the incorporation as a village of the following territory, all of which is in said Kittson County, Minnesota, and is described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the First Addition to Humbolt, running thence Southeasterly along the East line of said First Addition to Humbolt, to the Southeast corner thereof, running thence Southwesterly along the South line of Davis Street to it's intersection with second avenue, running thence Southeasterly along the East line of Second avenue if projected in a straight line to a point two rods South of the North line of section 26 in township 163 North, range 50 West, running thence West and parallel to said section line to the East line of the right of way of the Great Northern Railway Co., running thence Southeasterly along the East line of said right of way to a point 300 feet South of said section line, running thence West and parallel to said section line to a point 600 feet West of the quarter section line of said section 26, running thence North parallel to the East line of section 26 and section 23 to the point of intersection with the North line, projected Southwesterly, of said First Addition to Humbolt, running thence Northwesterly along said projected line and along the real North line of said First Addition to Humbolt to the place of beginning, said territory comprising approximately seventy-six acres of land and including within it's boundaries all of the land in the plats of the townsite of Humbolt and the First Addition to Humbolt.

We, T. R. Brown, G. V. Clow and Albert Brown, who were appointed by resolution of the county board of Kittson County, dated September 2, 1919, as inspectors to act as judges at the election held on September 29, 1919, in the town of Humbolt in said county, on the question of incorporation of the village of Humbolt, do hereby certify and return;

That under and pursuant to the resolution of the county board of Kittson County, Minnesota, dated September 2, 1919, an election was held at the hall over James Florance's store, in the town of Humbolt, between the hours of 9 A. M. and 9 P. M., on September 29, 1919.
