PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the continued future progress of the State of Minnesota is to a large extent dependent on the total good health of its children and youth, the citizens of tomorrow; and

WHEREAS, total good health--physical and mental--can be achieved through good health habits, learned early; and

WHEREAS, The Minnesota Dental Association and the Minnesota Department of Public Health maintain continuing educational programs in support of good dental health habits for young people and of fluoridation of public water supplies to prevent dental disease;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 2 through 8, 1969 as

"CHILDREN'S DENTAL HEALTH WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge that all citizens and all community organizations join in the observance thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
