PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the development of Minnsota can be attributed to the foresighted people who saw the need for an improved transportation system, and
- UNEREAS, the agricultural, economic and industrial development of the State of Minnesota, both in the metropolitan and rural areas, is dependent on an efficient highway system, and
- WHEREAS, expansion of the tourist industry depends on an adequate highway and road system, and
- WHEREAS, future generations will see an even more demanding increase in traffic volume than we have experienced in recent times, and
- WHEREAS, the history of Minnesota's highway programs has been an example of awareness, progress and initiative, and
- WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota, as well as the thousands engaged in highvay-associated industries, are the beneficiaries of efforts by the advocates of better roads, and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota Godd Roads, Inc., beginning on January 25, 1893, has been the leader and the coordinator of every effort in the highway transportation field, from bringing Minnesota 'out of the mud" to the modern four-lane Interstate highways of today,

MON, THEREFORE, I. Herold LaVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 25-31, 1969 as

"MINNESOTA GOOD ROADS DAY"

in Minnesota, on the organization's 76th Anniversary, and urgo the citizens of our State to support the continued efforts of this organization and others to secure an adequate transportation system to meet the economic and sefety needs of this century and the next.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affined at the State Capitol this Eventy-seventh day of Jenuary in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
