WHEREAS, our more than 30,000 Minnesota school safety patrol members have given their services to make 1969 another safe year for Minnesota school children, and

WHEREAS, these dedicated boys and girls have accepted assignments of grave responsibility and performed their duties well, and

WHEREAS, their guidance and example have taught our children of both public and private schools to walk safely and to obey traffic regulations at all times, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota has pioneered in this activity, starting more than 40 years ago, and

WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota are grateful to these young people for their contribution to safety, and wish to take occasion to express their appreciation

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 16-22, 1969 as
