WHEREAS, Vocational-technical education has made a major contribution to the citizens and economic growth in the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, a viable vocational-technical education system is essential for the future development of its people and economic growth, and

WHEREAS, vocational-technical education is entering its fifty-second year of service to the citizens of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 23 through March 1, 1969 as

"VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be cognizant of the many contributions made to our state by vocational-technical education and to encourage and support further expansion of vocational-technical education as an integral part of continuing education.
