

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS. construction is the largest single industry in the Mation and in Minnesota;
- the economic well-being of the state and that of all Minnesota is directly WHEREAS, effected by the efforts of the industry in its attempts to safeguard the individual workmen in construction; and
- whereas. these groups are concerned with the rising costs of accidents and a reduction in the costs of construction to the public; and
- WHEREAS, Associated General Contractors of Minnesote, governmental agencies and organized labor have each year made progress in Industrial Safety; and
- WHEREAS. the industry has, over the years, recognized those firms, individuals, and organizations in their attempts to reduce the frequency and severity of accidents in the construction industry, through annual recognition awards; and
- umereas. these groups have cooperated to sponsor a special day-long program to further interest in, and practice of, safety in the construction industry

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Marold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Friday, March 7, 1969 as

"CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY SAFETY DAY"

in Minnesota, and uzge the public of the State of Minnesota to continue to support the ideals, and efforts of this industry in its attempt to decrease the occurrence of accidence is the construction industry and to thereby provide for a better indust and honce a better use of public monies in the taxpayers behalf.
