PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, each year about 500 Minnesotans lose their lives where they feel most safe and secure--in their own homes. If we are to prevent this needless loss of life and property, an increasing emphasis must be placed on greater awareness of safe living practices; and

WHEREAS, we recognize this need for a coordinated home safety campaign in Minnesota, the America Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States have joined forces with the Metropolitan Area Safety Council of Minnesota and Minnesota Safety Council to fight the war on accident

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the time of April 7 to May 7, 1969, as

"HOME SAFETY MONTH"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of this state to cooperate in this home safety efforts

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
