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# AN ORDINANGE DEGLARING CERTAIN PLATTED LANDS TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF NORTH MANKATO, MINNESOTA 

Common Council of the City of North Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

1. All of the tracts of land lying adjacent to the City of North Mankato and being in the County of Nicollet and described as follows:

TRACT I:
The tract of land lying and being in Nicollet County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at a point 40 rods east from the southwest corner of Government Lot 1 in Section 11, Township 108 North, Range 27 West, on the south line of said Government Lot 1, and running from thence north parallel to the east line of said Government Lot 1, to an elm tree that is marked and standing in a Ravine known as the "Stone Quarry Ravine", thence in a southeasterly direction down said ravine to the Minnesota River, thence westerly along said river to a point where the south line of said Government Lot 1 intersects said river; and thence along said south line of said Government Lot 1 , to the place of beginning, less the west 50 feet lying south of the private road.

That part of that tract or parcel of land as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point where the center line of the public road up Big Hill cuts the center line running north and south in said Government Lot 1, Section 11, Township 108 north of Range 27 West, and running from thence southeasterly along the center line os said public road to a point 14 rods east of the said center line of Government Lot 1, thence southwesterly in a straight line a distance of about 12 rods to the center line of the there lowest level of Stone Quarry Ravine, at a point $3 \frac{1}{2}$ rods east of the said center line of said Government Lot 1, thence northwesterly a distance of about $3 \frac{1}{2}$ rods along the center line of the there lowest level of said ravine to the said center line of Government Lot 1 , and thence north along the said center line a distance of about 8 rods to the place of beginning, lying south of the private road running in a northeasterly and southwesterly direction.
