ORDINANCE NO. 1967-1-H

**AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MELROSE, STEARNS COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS**

WHEREAS, a certain Petition, dated this 2nd day of November, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory herein described, was duly presented to the Council on the 7th day of November, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is approximately less than one (1) acre of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by the owner, and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality, who boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts the City of Melrose at the Southerly boundary thereof.

The Council of the City of Melrose, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected, (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character, and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.


Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Three (3), Township One Hundred Twenty-five (125) North, of Range Thirty-three (33) West, in Stearns County, Minnesota, which lies Southerly of the North 200 feet of said Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 SE 1/4) and which is contained in the following description: That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE 1/4 of SE 1/4), of Section Numbered Three (3), in Township Numbered One Hundred Twenty-five (125) North, of Range Numbered Thirty-three (33) West, which lies East of County State Aid Highway Number 13 as now exists and South of County Road No. 173 as now exists, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the East Quarter Corner of said Section 3; thence South 00°48' West and along the Section line a distance of 114.38 feet to the South Right-of-way line of said County Road No. 173; thence North 89°10' West and along said South Right-of-way line of County Road No. 173 a distance of 498.9 feet to the point of beginning of the tract to be described; thence at right angles South 00°50' West 200 feet; thence at right angles North 89° 10' West 247 feet, more or less, to the intersection with Ely Right-of-way line of said County State Aid Highway No. 13, thence NEly on said Right-of-way line of said County State Aid Highway No. 13 to the Sly Right-of-Way line of said County Road No. 173; thence at right angles East on and along the Sly Right-of-Way line of said County Road No. 173 for a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating, in Stearns County, Minnesota. (Property to be annexed contains less than one acre)

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.




