ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE VILLAGE OF WILLERNIE,
VIACULUTY, MINNEEGTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
THATTED AND UNPLATTED
LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200
ACRES.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLERNIE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section I. A Petition having been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Willernie, Minnesota, by all in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Willernie, Minnesota:

Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9), Block No. 8 of Glenmar, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the of-fice of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, including that partion of Bea-conslield Road, also known as County State Aid Highway No. 36, lying adjacent thereto,

Section 2. The petition is made and filed pursuant to the provisions of Suldivison 2 of Section 414.03 of Minnesota Statutes Annotated, with notice of the petition and the petition given to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town of Lincoln and Board of County Commissioners of Washington County.

Section 3. A quantity of land embraced in the foregoing description does not exceed 200 acres.

section 4. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Willernie, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof, together with that portion of Beaconsfield Road also known as County State Aid Highway No. 36, lying adjacent thereto.

Section 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This Ordinance takes feet upon its passage and publication and the filing of the copies directed in Section 6.
