Ordinance No. 26

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF UNDERWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

Whereas, a certain petition dated March 6th, 1967, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 6 Day of March, 1967; and

Whereas, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is one (1) acre of unplatted land, more or less, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

Whereas, the petition was signed by all owners; and

Whereas, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

Whereas, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the Northwest (NW) boundary thereof;

The council of the village of Underwood, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Beginning at a point on the Northwest corner of Woodland Avenue of Underwood, Minnesota as platted, which point is on the high water line of Bass Lake, thence due South along the West line of the Village of Underwood, Minnesota, a distance of 150 feet, thence due West, a distance of 75 feet, thence due North and parallel to the West line of the Village limits to the high water line of Bass Lake, then in a Southwesterly direction along the shore of said lake to the point of beginning. Part of Government Lot 10, Section 32, Township 133, Range 41.

Section 3. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
