ORDINANCE No. 96

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEFIELD, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCOPROATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain Petition, dated 15 July 1968, requesting annexation of the territory hereafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 15th day of July , 1968; and

WFEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is 80 acres, more or less of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all the owners; and
WHEREAS, no bejections to the annexation have been received from the
Town Board, County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose
boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts upon the village limits at the Northern boundary thereof;

The Council of the Village of Lakefield, Jackson County, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is or about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village of Lakefield are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows; and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village of Lakefield as affectually as if it had originally been a part thereof, and shall hereafter be known as the Kienietz Addition to the Village of Lakefield.

The North Half $(N\frac{1}{2})$ of the Northwest Quarter $(N\frac{1}{2})$ of Section 33, Township 103 North, Range 36, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Jackson County, Minnesota

Section 3 Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.
