- WHEREAS, it is appropriate and important that we pay special recognition to the art of figure skating and its significant contribution to entertainment and sport in America's history; and
- WHEREAS, Shipstad and Johnson Ice Follies, the world's original ice show, was founded 33 years ago in St. Paul by Eddie Shipstad, Oscar Johnson and Roy Shipstad who still produce it; and
- WHEREAS, the Ice Follies is now owned by Medical Investment Corporation, Minneapolis, Thomas K. Scallen, President; and
- WHEREAS, graceful and talented Miss Peggy Fleming, only gold medalist for the United States in the 1968 winter Olympics; three-time world figure skating champion, and five-time United States figure skating champion, is special guest star with the 1969 Ice Follies; and
- WHEREAS, the 1969 Ice Follies with Peggy Fleming as special guest star will open a 12-day engagement at the Metropolitan Sports Center on March 25, 1969




and March 26, 1969 as
