

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, Minnesota now leads the nation in the production of turkeys with almost 17 million birds raised in 1969, and,
- WHEREAS, production of turkeys constitutes more than \$50 million in agricultural income annually which is important to the economy of the State, representing almost three per cent of the total cash receipts from farm marketing, and,
- WHEREAS, Turkey meat is wholesome, nutritious and easy to prepare, and,
- WHEREAS, there is today a plentiful supply of turkeys at reasonable prices as a result of scientific breeding and improved production practices to enhance the turkey in quality, size and taste,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lowland, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1969, as

"TURKEY MONTH"

in Minnesota, and call upon the entire turkey industry in this State, our citizens, our press and private and public organizations to join in its observance that we may learn more of the value of turkey as a food for all seasons.


