WHEREAS, the art of square dancing is unique to our country's history and an integral and increasingly important part of the recreation of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, in encouraging our citizens' participation in square dancing we stimulate their interest in their pioneer heritage that is basic to this form of modern recreation; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota will assemble during the month of June in the City of Moorhead for their eighteenth annual State Square Dance Convention

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lowander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 19th through June 20th, 1969 as

"SQUARE DANCE WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and pay tribute to the fine work of this group in providing wholesome entertainment and encouraging a sense of appreciation of the customs and traditions of our country.
