





PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Honorable Village Council of the Village of Watertown:

We, the undersigned Petitioners, hereby respectfully represent
and State:

That the undersigned Petitioners desire and request that
certain lands be annexed to the Village of Watertown, Carver County,
Minnesota, and included within its corporate limits, said lands being
more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4; and also all of that part of the
Southwest Quarter of said Section 4, lying South-
easterly of the Crow River and Northeasterly of
the plat of the Village of Watertown, all in Section
4, Township 117, Range 25, Carver County, Minnesota,
said land being approximately 49.01 acres, more
or less.


That the undersigned Petitioners are all of the owners of
the said lands herein described which are proposed to be annexed
to the Village of Watertown.

That the said above described lands abut the present
corporate limits of the Village of Watertown; that the area
proposed to be annexed does not exceed 200 acres in area; and
that said lands are not now included in any other municipality.

That your Petitioners verily believe that said lands are
conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government
and that such annexation would be to the best interests of the
Village of Watertown and of the above described lands proposed
to be annexed.

ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE INCORPORATED
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, a certain Petition, dated the 4th day of February, 1969, and requesting annexation to the Village of Watertown of certain territory described below, was duly presented to the Village Council of the Village of Watertown, on the 4th day of March, 1969, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 414.03; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that said Petition was signed by all of the owners of said lands and is suitable and proper in all respects; and

WHEREAS, copies of said Petition were duly forwarded on March 7, 1969, to the Clerk of the Town Board of the Township of Watertown, the County Auditor of the County of Carver, and the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, more than thirty days have elapsed since the dates of said filing and no objections have been made in writing, or otherwise, to the Village of Watertown as to the annexation proposed by said Petition:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that a copy of said Petition was duly mailed, as required by law, to the Town Board of the Town of Watertown, the Carver County Board, and the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, and that no objection to the proposed annexation has been made by any of said parties or filed with the Village Council; that the territory described below abuts upon the present corporate limits of the Village of Watertown; that said lands do not exceed 200 acres in area; that said lands are not now included in any other municipality;

that said lands are conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government; and that the annexation of said lands would be to the best interests of the Village of Watertown and the Territory to be annexed.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Watertown are hereby extended to encompass and embrace all of the territory described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4, Township 117, Range 25 lying Northeasterly of the present corporate limits of the Village of Watertown;

ALSO, the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 4, all of the above being in Section 4, Township 117, Range 25, Carver County, Minnesota, said land being approximately 49.1 acres, more or less.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State, and the Auditor of Carver County, as required by law.

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be deemed final upon the filing of this Ordinance as set forth in Section 3 and publication of same as required by law.
