ORDINANCE NO. 335

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE
CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS

The City Council of the City of Thief River Falls do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1.

WHEREAS all of the owners of the following described premises situated in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

A tract of land located in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township 154 North, Range 43 West, described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point 200' South of the Northwest corner of Block 9 in Oakland Addition to Thief River Falls; thence running West 160.02'; thence running South 100'; thence running East 160.02' to the West Line of Oakland Addition; thence running North along the West line of Oakland Addition a distance of 100' to the point of beginning.

A tract of land in Township 154 North, Range 43 West, in Pennington County, Minnesota, as follows:

Commencing at that certain point where the West Line of State Avenue North intersects with the North Line of Eighth Street in the City of Thief River Falls, Minnesota, as shown by the Plats on file in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Pennington County, Minnesota; thence from said Point of beginning running West to the East Boundary Line of the Great Northern Railway Right of Way; thence running South along the said East Boundary Line of the said present Boundary Line of the Great Northern Railway Right of Way a distance of Two Hundred Ten (210) Feet; thence again running directly East at Right Angles to the West Boundary Line of the present State Avenue North; thence again running North along the West Boundary Line of the said State Avenue a distance of Two Hundred Ten (210) Feet to the Point of beginning,

have petitioned the City Council to have such land included within the municipality and have filed copies of said petition with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of the Township of North and with the County Board of the County of Pennington, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS the above described property abuts upon the boundaries of the City of Thief River Falls and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby determined that the annexation of said premises will be to the best interest of the City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Commission, the Pennington County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

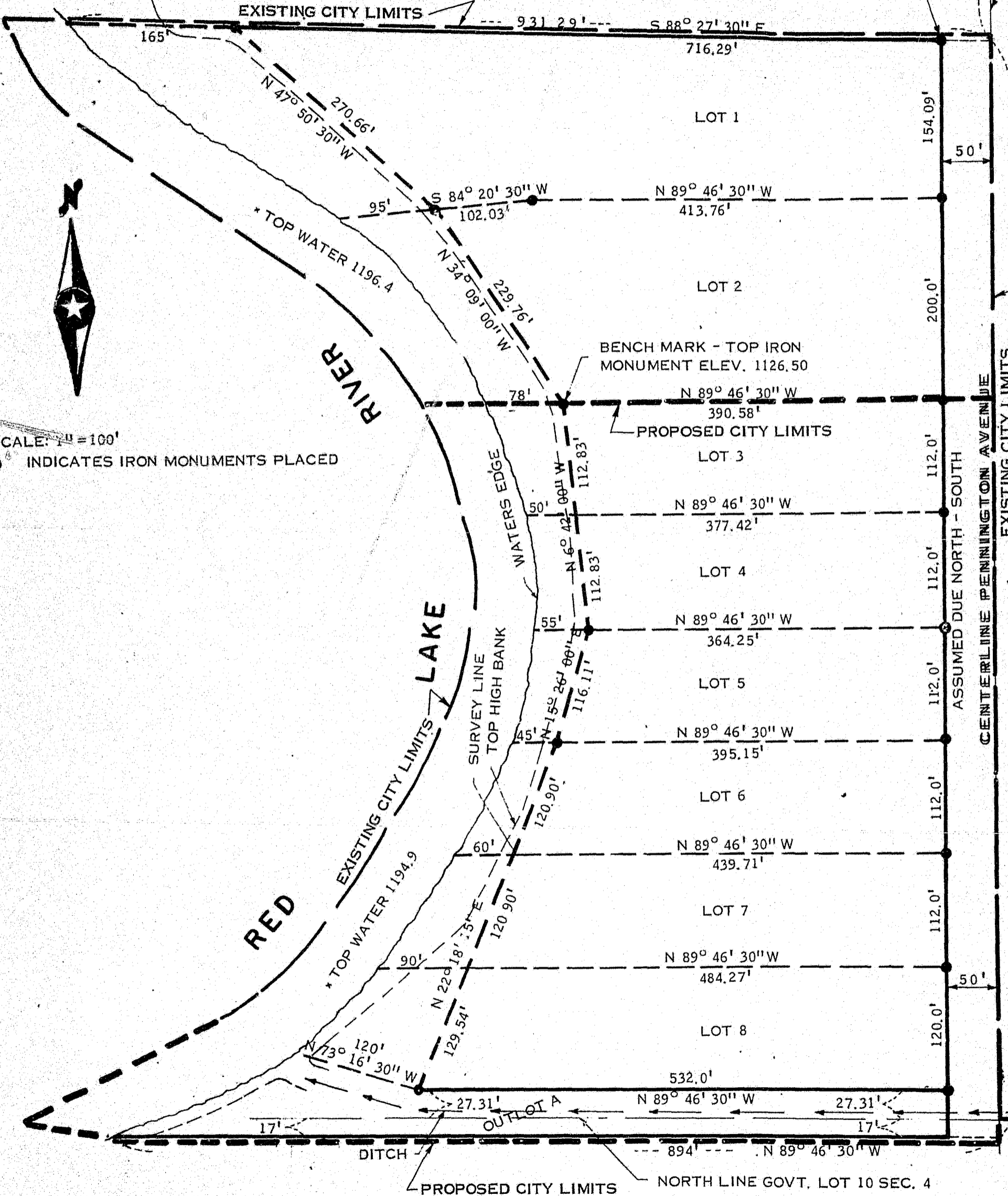
