AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CANBY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. The following described land is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits of the City of Canby:

Beginning at a point where the Northwestern line of Outlot A of the 1944 Addition to the City of Canby intersects the Northeastly line of Minnesota Trunk Highway #68; thence Northeastly along the Northwestern line of Outlot A a distance of 400 feet; thence Northwesternly at right angles a distance of 220 feet; thence Southwesterly at right angles a distance of 400 feet to the Northeastly of Trunk Highway #68; thence Southeastly along said Northeastly line of Trunk Highway #68 to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The City Council hereby determines

- (1) That annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Canby, Minnesota, and of the territory affected;
- (2) That the territory described herein is completely surrounded by land within the municipal limits, is deemed to be urban in character and is so conditioned as to properly be subject to city government.

Section 3. The corporate limits of the City of Canby are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1. and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. The City Administrative Assistant is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 4.
