ORDINANCE NO. 1480

AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of Rochester, Mitmesota, Certain Platted Land Known as Lots 6, 7 and 8, Auditor's Plat "D", Oimsted County, Minnesota, The Common Council of the City of Rochester do ordain:

Section 1. A pellifion has been filled with the Common Council of the City of Rochester, signed by all the owners of the land described herein, requesting the Common Council to annex said land for the City of Rochester. The land described in said pellilion for annexation is located in Cascade Township, Oimsted County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:
