CHAPTER NO. 345

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
TO THE CITY OF SAUK CENTRE

THE CITY OF SAUK CENTRE DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1: That the following described real property adjoins the City Limits of Sauk Centre and is located in the County of Stearns, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Lots One (1), Two (2), and Three (3) and the Northerly Sixteen (16) feet of Lot Four (4) of Auditor's Subdivision of the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Fifteen (15), Township One Hundred Twenty-six (126), Range Thirty-four (34) in Stearns County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2: That the owner of the said land, has petitioned the City of Sauk Centre to have the said land annexed, added into and made a part of the City of Sauk Centre.

SECTION 3: That copies of the petition for said annexation were filed with the Townboard of Sauk Centre Township, the Stearns County Board of Commissioners, and the Municipal Commission.

SECTION 4: That it will be in the best interest of the said City of Sauk Centre that the said lands be annexed to the said City, and said lands are hereby annexed, taken into and are hereby made a part of the said City of Sauk Centre in Stearns County, Minnesota.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance will take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its publication.

CHAPTER NO. 345

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS

TO THE CITY OF SAUK CENTRE
