Ordinance # 72

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Cologne, to include certain unplatted lands, not exceeding 200 acres

Section 1. - A petition having been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Cologne, by Urban H. Fritz and Alice F. Fritz, the owners of the following described real estate, to have such lands included within the Village of Cologne, Minnesota.

Commencing at a point 33 feet North and 213 feet East, from the Southwest corner of the North half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 115, Range 25; thence North 132½ feet to a point; thence East 20 feet to a point; thence South 132½ feet to a point; thence West 20 feet to the place of beginning, containing .06 acre, more or less, and situate in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 13, Township 115 Range 25,

Section 2. - The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described is .06 acres.

Section 3. - The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of ~~Hamburg~~ ^{Cologne}, Minn., and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abutts upon the Village of Cologne, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. - Therefore, the Village of Cologne, Minn., hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Cologne, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. - This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
