
Reposing especial trust and confidence in your prudence, integrity and ability I have appointed you

ARTICLE VI, SECTION 11.


You are therefore by these presents, appointed and commissioned MUNICIPAL JUDGE, CITY

Capitol, in the City of Saint Paul, this


