ORDINANCE NO. 361

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE  
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE TO  
INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT  
EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of  
the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota by the sole owners of the following  
described real estate to have such land included within the City of White Bear  
Lake, Minnesota:

Except the East Seventy (70') feet, the Westerly One hun-  
dred fifty (150') feet of the Easterly 310.86 feet of Govern-  
ment Lot Four (4) lying North of Lakeview Avenue extending  
from Lakeview Avenue northerly to White Bear Lake, all in  
Government Lot Four (4) Section 23, Township 30, Range 22,  
including all riparian rights appertaining thereto, said property  
property being owned by Kenneth W. Bacchus and Anita M.  
Bacchus

and

The East Seventy (70') feet of the Westerly One Hundred Fifty  
(150') feet of the easterly 310.86 feet of Government Lot Four  
(4) lying North of Lakeview avenue extending from Lakeview Avenue  
northerly to White Bear Lake, all in Government Lot Four  
(4) Section 23, Township 30, Range 22, including all riparian  
rights appertaining thereto, said property being owned by  
Kenneth W. Bacchus, Inc.

Section 2. The quantity of lands embraced within the foregoing  
descriptions and bounded as described, each is less than 200 acres.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the an-  
nexations will be to the best interests of the City of White Bear Lake, Minnesota,  
and of the territories affected; (2) that the territories described herein abut upon  
the City and each is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.


