ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TO THE VILLAGE OF TYLER, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Tyler, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

1. That the sole owner of the real estate hereinafter described has petitioned the Village Council to annex to and incorporate said land in the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.
2. That said land is unplatted, consists of less than 100 acres, and abuts on said Village of Tyler.
3. That it is for the best interests of all concerned that said land be so annexed to the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.
4. That the real estate lying and being in the County of Lincoln, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the north line of Section Ten (10), in Township One Hundred Nine (109) North, Range Forty-four (44) West of the 5th P. M., three hundred ten and two-tenths (310.2) feet east of the northwest corner of Government Lot No. One (1) in said section ten (10) and running thence in a southerly direction at right angles with said north line of said section ten (10) four hundred forty-five and five-tenths (445.5) feet; thence in a westerly direction parallel to said north line of said section ten (10) three hundred ten and two-tenths (310.2) feet to a point in the west line of said Government Lot One (1); thence south along said west line of said Government Lot one (1), one hundred forty-eight and five-tenths (148.5) feet thence in an easterly direction, parallel to said north line of said section ten (10) thirteen hundred thirty and ninety-three one-hundredths (1330.93) feet; thence north at right angles with said north line of said section ten (10) five hundred ninety-four (594) feet to a point in said north line of said section ten (10) thence west along said north line of said section ten (10), ten hundred twenty and seventy-three one-hundredths (1020.73) feet, to the point of beginning, containing fifteen (15) acres, more or less, according to the survey thereof, including abutting streets, highways and right-of way.

That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication and upon filing a copy of said ordinance with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of the County of Lincoln, Minnesota.
