

ORDINANCE NO. 401

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty Three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-One (41), described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Easterly boundary of the right of way of U. S. Highway No. 59 distant 75.0 feet East and 265.0 feet North of the West Quarter corner of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112), Range Forty-one (41), which point shall be designated as point of beginning; thence in a Northerly direction along said Easterly boundary of said right of way line a distance of 50.0 feet; thence in an Easterly direction parallel to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  line to a point 320 feet West of the Westerly boundary of the railway right of way of the Great Northern Railway, formerly known as the Willmar and Sioux Falls Railway; thence in a Southerly direction parallel to the West line of said Section, a distance of 50 feet; thence in a Westerly direction parallel to said  $\frac{1}{4}$  line to the place of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 1.74 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
