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ORDINANCE NO. 399

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have said real estate annexed to and included within the corporate limits of said City:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SWLSEL) of Section 9, Township 111, Range 41, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of Section 9, Township 111, Range 41, which is 8 rods and 3 feet north of the south line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of said Section 9; thence running north along the west line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of said Section 9, a distance of 150 feet; thence running east and parallel with the south line of the Southwest Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of said Section 9, a distance of 200 feet; thence running south and parallel with the west line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\)) of said Section 9, a distance of 150 feet; thence running west a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning, property subject to existing highways.

Section 2. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have said real estate annexed to and included within the corporate limits of said City:

All that part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter (SaSWa) of Section Thirty-three (33), Township One Hundred Twelve (112) North, Range Forty-one (41) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at a Judicial landmark on the South line of Section 33, Township 112 North, Range 41 West, which is 1215.5 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Section 33; thence East along the South line of said Section 33, a distance of 925.5 feet to the Judicial landmark on the edge of the Redwood River; thence North 24055' West, along the river's edge, a distance of 63.2 feet to a Judicial landmark; thence North 24020' West, along the river's edge, a distance of 438 feet to a Judicial landmark; thence North 03055' East along the river's edge, a distance of 168 feet to a Judicial landmark; thence North 18027' East along the river's edge, a distance of 66 feet to a Judicial landmark; thence South 870561 West, a distance of 87.65 feet to a Judicial landmark; thence South 46017' West, a distance of 832.3 feet, to a Judicial landmark; thence South 29037' West, a distance of 124.45 feet to the point of beginning, excepting therefrom the right of way of existing. road.

Section 3. The aggregate quantity of land embraced within the foregoing decoration and described protested acceptance and decoration area.

Section 4. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexations will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 5. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the sems is hereby assessed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
