

WHEREAS, The Honorable Arnold Hatfield, Judge of the District Court of the Third Judicial District, State of Minnesota, under date of July 1, 1969, has submitted his written application for retirement pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 490.101, sub-division 2 and


WHEREAS, Judge Hatfield has served as a District Judge from the Third Judicial District of the State of Minnesota a total of 16 years and 7 months and was most recently elected to a six year term commencing January 1, 1967 and

WHEREAS, Judge Hatfield's attending physician has submitted in writing his opinion that because of recent heart surgery for aortic valve disease and failing health by reason of severe asthmatic bronchitis said Judge Hatfield is physically incapable of performing the duties required by the position of Judge of the District Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That having determined that said Judge Hatfield is in fact physically handicapped and incapable of performing his judicial duties by reason of such incapacity and disability, it is hereby ordered that the application by Judge Hatfield for retirement as here and before recited shall be accepted and his retirement for the unexpired portion of his term is hereby directed effective at the close of business August 31, 1969. It is further ordered that a copy of this order be filed with the Secretary of State and the State Auditor together with a copy to the Honorable Arnold Hatfield.
