

INSPECTORS' CERTIFICATE TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED INSPECTORS appointed by the County Board of Carlton County, Minnesota, acting as Judges of Election in the matter of the proceedings to incorporate the proposed Village of Wright in said County, do hereby certify and declare that between the hours of 9 A. M. and 5 P. M., inclusive on February 4th, 1920, at the Farmers' Hall within the territory included in the proposed Village of Wright, an election pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 9, G. S. 1913, as amended, was duly held for the purpose of determining the question of incorporation of said proposed Village of Wright; that we have canvassed the ballots cast thereat, and the number cast both for and against said proposition, and that 35 of said ballots cast were for incorporation, and 2 of said ballots were cast against incorporation.

NOTICE OF ELECTION.

WHEREAS, A census in due form has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Carlton County, Minnesota, showing that certain territory, in certain petition described, has a population of 186; and  
WHEREAS, A duly verified petition, purporting to <sup>be</sup> in due form and signed by at least 35 voters residing within said territory, to-wit; All of Section 4 and West half of Section 3, including the platted parts thereof, in Township 48, Range 21, praying that said territory be incorporated into a Village to be known as the Village of Wright, was presented to this board at a session thereof held on January 6th, 1930, for the action of said board thereon; and,

WHEREAS, The said petition has been duly approved by this board.

THEREFORE, in pursuance to the provision of Statute in such case made and provided;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That an Election will be held at the Farmers Hall at Wright on Wednesday February 4th, 1930, at the hour of 9 o'clock A. M. and ~~xx~~ proceeding as provided for election of town officers, at which time and place the voters of said territory may vote for or against the incorporation of said territory into a Village.

It is Ordered, That Henry Groth, J. D. Jones and Henry Rose ~~is~~ is appointed as inspectors to act as judges of said election.

WRIGHT, MINNESOTA, JANUARY 2, 1920.

TO  
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, of CARLTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA,  
CARLTON, MINNESOTA.

Gentlemen:-

The undersigned respectfully represent to your honorable body that they constitute twenty-five (25) or more voters residing within the territory hereinafter referred to, to-wit: Section Four (4) and the West half ( $W\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section Three (3), in Township Forty-eight (48), Range Twenty-one (21), in Carlton County, Minnesota, containing approximately 570 acres, and the platted lands forming a part thereof, the Plats of which are hereinafter described: That none of said lands are in any incorporated village. That a portion thereof has been platted into lots and blocks, and such plats are known and designated in the public records as hereinafter specified, and that each of said plats has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds for said Carlton County, all of said territory containing a resident population of not more than Three Thousand (3000) nor less than one hundred (100). Said platted lands are known and described as follows to-wit:

TOWN OF WRIGHT, on the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Four (4); beginning at a point thirty-three (33) feet south from the center line of said Section Four (4), six hundred fifty-one (651) feet west from the quarter stake on the east line of said section, running thence south one hundred seventy (170) feet, thence west five hundred sixty (560) feet, thence east five hundred sixty (560) feet to the place of beginning, making two and twenty-hundredths acres (2.20 A.):

PEASES PLAT of Wright on the North Half of the Southeast quarter ( $N\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Four (4); commencing on the north and south center line of said section Four (4) at a magnetic variation of 8 degrees 40 minutes east, 2314 feet North of the quarter section corner between said Section Four (4) and Section Nine (9), running thence to a point on the right of way of the Northern Pacific Railway Company, 200 feet south of the center of the track on the main line thence at a course north  $48\frac{1}{4}$  degrees East and parallel with said Railway track 1443 feet, thence at right angles at a course south  $5\frac{1}{4}$  degrees, East 798 feet, thence at right angles at a course South  $84$  degrees west 1524 feet to the North and south center line of said Section Four (4), thence north on said center line 802 feet to the place of beginning.

PEASES EAST ADDITION to Wright: Beginning at a point on the Section line of said Section Four (4), - 363 feet south of the quarter corner between Section Three (3) and Section Four (4), running thence south along said section line 954 feet, thence west at an angle of  $87\frac{1}{2}$  degrees 1380 feet, thence in the northwesterly direction 469 feet to Johnson Avenue according to Pease's Plat of Wright, thence in a northeasterly direction along the south side of said Johnson Avenue 366 feet, thence in a northwesterly direction along the east side of Fourth Street according to said Pease's Plat of Wright, 432 feet, thence east 224 feet, thence north 153 feet to the south side of Block number Two (2) according to the Plat of the Town of Wright, thence East along the South side of said Plat of the Town of Wright 290 feet, thence north along the East line of said Plat of the Town of Wright, 170 feet, thence East parallel with and 33 feet south of the quarter line 270 feet, thence South along the west side of School ground 330 feet, thence East along the south side of said school ground 363 feet to the point of beginning, containing 31.1 acres of land more or less:

PEASE'S SOUTH ADDITION to Wright : Beginning on the section line along the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Four (4), at a point 825 feet West of the Southeast corner of said Section Four (4), running thence northerly parallel with the East line of said Section 1289.5 feet to an iron monument on the north line of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section, thence Westerly along the North line to the Northwest corner of said Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said forty, 1273 feet, thence east along the south line of said Section to the place of beginning, a distance of 530 feet containing sixteen (16) acres of land more or less.

That the unplatted part of such territory adjoins said platted portions and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to the village government:

Your Petitioners herewith submit to you as a part hereof, a Census in due form of law, of the resident population showing the population of said territory to be within the numbers specified in Chapter 324 of the Session Laws of 1919, - said resident population being now 186 and respectfully request that you proceed to incorporate said territory as the Village of Wright.
