ORDINANCE No. 2-1969

AN OMPHANOE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LINITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAYNESVILLY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED ON THREE SIDES BY LAND SITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND QUITING THEFEON.

MERCAS, certain territory described below as not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or berough; and

WENGAS, this territory is Seventy Five (75%) percent bordered on three sides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the Village and is desmed to be urban/character; and

WHEREAS, notice of intent to amex said lands was served upon the officers of the Town Board of Paynesville Township on April 1, 1969;

HOW THEMEFORE, The Village Connoil of the Village of Paymesville ordeins:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Paymenville, Minesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory is now and has heretofore been Seventy Five (75%) percent bordered on three sides by territory slready included within the Village limits:

> The westerly Twenty One (21) rods of the Easterly Thirty One (31) rods of that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NWESWE) of Section Sixteen (16), Township One Hundred Twenty Two (122), North of Range Thirty Two (32) West, Steams County, Minnesota, lying Northerly of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 55.

Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor and the Register of Deeds of the County in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Aunicipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective date of Ameration. This Ordinance takes effect upon pessage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
