ORDINANCE NO. 3-1969

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAINESVILLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BORDERED ON THREE SIDES BY LAND WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND ADJUTING THEREON.

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, this territory is Seventy Five (75%) percent bordered on three sides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the Village and is deemed to be urban in character; and

WHEREAS, notice of intent to annex said lands was served upon the officers of the Town Board of Painesville Township on April 1, 1969;

NOW THEREFORE, The Village Council of the Village of Painesville ordains:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Painesville, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory is new and has heretofore been Seventy Five (75%) percent bordered on three sides by territory already included within the Village limits:

The westerly Twenty Two and one-half (22½) rods ~~of the that part~~ of that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW¼SW¼) Section Sixteen (16), Township One Hundred Twenty Two (122) North, of Range Thirty Two (32) West, lying Northerly of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 55.

Section 2. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor and the Register of Deeds of the County in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Section 3. Effective date of Annexation. This Ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
