AN ONDIVANCE EXPENDING THE CORPORATE LIGHTS OF THE VILLAGE OF PAYMESVILLE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY BONDERED ON THESE SIDES BY LAND LITHUR THE VILLAGE LIGHTS AND ABSTRICT THEREON.

tHEMEAS, certain torritory described below to not presently included within the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or berough; and

VHIMELS, this territory is Seventy Five (75%) percent bordered on three cides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the Village and is decred to be urban in character; and

Thereas, notice of intent to amos said lands was served upon the officers of the Town Board of Paymesville Township on April 1, 1969;

MON THEREFORE, The Villago Council of the Villago of Paynooville ordains

Section 1. Territory Amond. The corporate limits of the Village of Phynesville, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the unplatted territory described as follows, which territory is now and has heretofore been Seventy Five (75%) percent bordered on three sides by territory already included within the Village limits:

The Mesterly Thenty Two and one-half (22%) rods of the thet wert of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NWSSE) Esstion Sixteen (16), Tomship One Mundred Twenty Two (122) North, of Menge Thirty Two (32) West, lying Northerly of Minnesota Trunk Mighway No. 55.

Section 2. Filing. The Village Clark is hereby directed to file cortified copies of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor and the Register of Deeds of the County in which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Countsision.

Section 3. Effective date of Americation. This Ordinance takes offect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.
